"HE IS RISEN INDEED!"



I have an exciting word from the Lord to share with you, but let me start by saying from all of us at Heartland, we pray that you have a blessed resurrection season. Now for the word of the Lord. There are times and seasons in our life that never pass the same way again. However, this is a prophetic word and it will apply to you when you hear it, receive it and apply it. Now, even though I am communicating and recording this on March 30th 2010, there is a prophetic anointing on it that will apply to you whenever it is that you hear it or read it and apply it. Revelation recorded and communicated brings inspiration and I pray that this word inspires you.

This past Sunday we celebrated Palm Sunday, followed by passover, leading up to good Friday and into resurrection Sunday. This is a powerful season and time, it is a season that brings a powerful anointing for binding and loosening and releasing the power of the spoken word mixed with faith to obtain whatever we need for the work of God. I will give you an example: At this season when Jesus went into Jerusalem known as the triumphal entry, he told his disciples there was a ass tied with a colt, he said to the **loose them and bring them to me**, and if anyone ask you what you are doing, you are to say the Lord had need of them. Jesus then rode into town on the best available means of transportation in his day. Religious people got upset about it then, and will get upset about it now. However, I am personally speaking the word and I am sending it forth into the spirit realm to loose and to call forth those things that I need for the work of the ministry. I encourage you to take that same authority to claim and proclaim what you have need of that will glorify God. The story goes on to tell when they came to a fig tree with no fruit how Jesus spoke the word and cursed the unprofitable thing. It is a season and a time to speak to whatever is unprofitable that would drain your time, energy or recourses and curse it from the root, let it wither up and dry. For I believe that we should judge things by the fruit that it produces, bad fruit or no fruit come from the roots. When Adam hid himself from the Lord he covered himself with a fig leaf speaking of hypocrisy. Jesus goes on to say "If we would have faith and do not doubt, we can not only do this,

but we can say to the mountain be removed **and it shall be done**". As we are in this highly anointed season speak to those mountains that are trying to hinder your purpose. I am going to use my God given authority right now and command the blessings of God to come upon you and overtake you, and you shall be blessed in the city, blessed in the field, above and not beneath the head and not the tail that the Lord would make His face shine upon you and in Jesus name I activate your faith to speak, to loose, receive, move and overcome and receive the blessings of the Lord in Jesus name.

So again carry this from this time forth and lets all walk in a greater anointing and revelation in the authority of the believer.
